Exterior House Renovations Nearly Complete

Renovations have started on the Fraternity House exterior and the House Parent Quarters inside. Although not finished as this is written, we are encouraged about the progress that we have made in a relatively short period of time. This phase of the project should be complete within 30 days.

As noted in the May 2008 Mountaineer Phi Psi, Linda James has been hired as the House Parent for 2008. This week she is greeting the 30+ brothers who have returned to Morgantown and will be living in the house during fall semester.

The new green metal roof looks outstanding and will be energy efficient. The front porch and balcony roof have been restructured and drainage problems have been eliminated. The new double pane windows will save on utility and maintenance expense. The House Mother's quarters will be finished when you get this letter.

Yes, we still have a long way to go. Donations and pledges are coming in. Many thanks to all those that are serving as Pledge Class Captains and those that have contributed or pledged to date.

We have structured an interest only loan and a draw against what we need up to \$1.5 million. At the end of all construction, it will be converted into a long term fixed rate mortgage. It is important that we pay down the construction loan as soon as possible before we convert it to a mortgage. Your immediate donations will help in that effort and provide a sound base for future maintenance and scholarship through the Alumni Funds.

For tax deductible contributions, make your donation to either the West Virginia Alpha Educational Fund or the Irene Hutchinson Phillips Memorial Fund. If tax deductibility is not a concern for you, you may donate directly to the James Cochran House Association. We can accept checks, stocks, mutual funds and real estate along with in kind donations. You can also donate through estate planning by listing the fraternity in your will.

We will start interior renovations next summer. The electrical, plumbing, heating and cooling all need upgrading. In addition we must bring the life safety needs up to code – fire sprinklers, fire suppression doors and security systems for entrances. Several of us are at the house everyday to assure the work is progressing and is correct.

The response to our survey overwhelmingly said to stay independent of WVU which we have done. The active chapter has filled the house for the fall semester which means we will be operating in the black. We finished last year in the black. The active chapter is doing their part, now it is up to each of us to do what we can to keep our fraternity debt free and a leader on WVU's campus.

As has been said before, it is hard to ask for money. Remember your experiences as an undergraduate in the chapter, your experience in life since college and how West Virginia Alpha Phi Kappa Psi helped that experience and then do what you can to give something back. Thank you.
