NEWS FROM MORGANTOWN AND CAMPUS...

- Mario's Fishbowl, a Morgantown landmark since 1950, has opened a second location on University Avenue, in Suncrest. Mario's has been in business at its Richwood Avenue location for more than 62-years. It is known for its 'fishbowls," frozen goblet-style glasses, and the walls that are covered with handwritten notes left by visitors.
- In October, WVU broke ground on the new Student Health and Wellness Center. The facility will be home to the College of Physical Activity and Sports Sciences (CPASS). The college has been housed in the coliseum since the 1970's. It is scheduled to be complete in 2014.
- Also in October WVU announced it had entered into a \$70MM public-private partnership to develop mixed use residential and retail complex in Sunnyside. The University states this project will help fulfill its strategic housing master plan which addresses the need for additional beds for international, professional and veteran students. They also note it fulfills the parent and student requests for more modern, private learning space close to campus.
- West Virginia University's total enrollment for fall 2012 rose by 90 students, bringing it to a record 29,706 students, and tied the largest freshman class ever: 5,135 in 2008. WVU had an 11.3% increase in international students, or 167 more students, for a total of 1,647. Many of the international students are from Saudi Arabia, an area of the world where WVU has a strong alumni base.

- For the first time in fifty-years, WVU has officially launched a new school with the start of the School of Public Health. It has started under the School of Medicine's umbrella as the Department of Community Medicine.
- The nationally ranked women's soccer team won the schools first-ever Big 12 Regular Season Championship.
- The National Institute of Health awarded a \$19.6MM grant to WVU to address health issues that most commonly affect West Virginians.
- **Richard "Rick" Wagener '69,** along with six very close friends, recently completed (October) to the Mt Everest Base Camp...at 17,500 feet.
- Charlie Mahan '57, former Dean and Professor Emeritus, University South Florida (USF), while sixyears retired, was awarded the 2012 Sapphire Award, as he has long been considered one of the greatest champion's of maternal and child health in the State of Florida. Mahan founded the Lawton and Rhea Chiles Center at USF. Charlie married Dee Jeffers on August 14 at the Waldorf Astoria in Naples, FL [special thanks to **Bob Pierce '39** for news about Brother Mahan].
- WVU will sell beer, in a limited capacity, at the Coliseum for men's basketball games this season. In 2011, the University made more than \$750K in beer sales at seven football games, and it appears they will exceed that number for the recently completed 2012 season.

Perhaps "out of sight, out of mind" is apparent. Through the efforts of our newsletter, Founder's Day and other activities we try to keep you informed. Please remind yourself of how Phi Psi has impacted you.
